

PART I: SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES

Section A - Rates for Metered Service

1. Customer Charge: Each customer will be assessed a customer service charge based upon the size of the customer's meter as follows:

<u>Meter Size</u>	<u>Per Quarter</u>
¾ inch	\$ 13.80 (i)
1 inch	\$ 24.00 (i)
1½ inch	\$ 48.00 (i)
2 inch	\$ 75.00 (i)
3 inch	\$ 138.00 (i)
4 inch	\$ 225.00 (i)
6 inch	\$ 450.00 (i)

2. Consumption Charge: In addition to the above Customer Charge, the following water consumption charges will apply for water supplied.

Rate per 1000 Gallons

\$5.20 (i)

Section B - Fire Protection Rates

1. Private Fire Protection: A customer charge for private fire protection service will be assessed as follows:

<u>Size of Connection</u>	<u>Per Quarter</u>	
2 inch	\$ 80.00	(i)
2½ inch	\$ 120.00	(i)
3 inch	\$ 180.00	(i)
4 inch	\$ 300.00	(i)
6 inch	\$ 680.00	(i)
8 inch	\$1,200.00	(i)

2. Public Fire Protection: For public fire protection, the charge shall be \$60 per (i) hydrant per quarter.

Section C - Returned Check Charge

A charge of \$30 will be assessed any time where a check which has been presented (i) to the Company for payment on account has been returned by the payor bank for any reason.

Section D - Construction Rates

The flat rate charge for unmetered residential building construction shall be \$60.00 (i) per quarter per dwelling unit under construction until construction is completed. The flat rate charge for unmetered nonresidential construction shall be \$60.00 per quarter.

Section E - Service Termination or Resumption Rates

The fee for shut-off or turn-on of service at the curb stop shall be \$60. (i)

(c) denotes change
(d) denotes decrease
(i) denotes increase

Section F - Meter Test Rates

Consistent with Commission regulation at 52 Pa. Code §65.8(h), the fee schedule for testing of meters shall be as follows:

1 inch or less	\$10.00
1¼ inch - 2 inch	\$20.00

These amounts may vary without revision of this tariff so as to be consistent with Commission regulations.

Fees for testing meters over 2 inches or for testing meters so located that testing costs are disproportionate to the stated fees shall be as established by the Company based upon the actual cost of the test.

Section G - Bulk Water Sales: For bulk water sales, the charge shall be:
